LEE MARTIN – President

Lee grew up in Boston and received a BA degree from Boston University and an MA from Duke. He began his career as a programmer and system designer, working on mainframes and PCs. His work experience includes systems for Grumman Aerospace, IBM, the State Department and the U.S. Navy. His final seven years were at CBN, managing the computer applications for the telethons.

With retirement, he began building models of square-rigger ships that dated from 1600 to 1800. About twelve years ago, he became the “model maker” for the Hampton Roads Naval Museum located inside Nauticus. At the museum, he builds models in full view of the visitors and has completed several which are now part of the museum. Lee is currently completing a large model of the USS Constitution for them.
