



AFRICAN AMERICAN HISTORY WALKING TOUR

Wednesday, September 20, 2023

10:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.

Let's take a walk back in history along Norfolk's scenic Waterside and the Elizabeth River. Fall is in the air as we walk along the Elizabeth River Trail, and explore Norfolk's role in the slave trade and Underground Railroad. We will learn some of the historic moments, heroes and sites of the pivotal history of the African American Experience in South Hampton Roads. Join fellow ILR members on Wednesday, September 20, 2023, 10:00 a.m. -11:30 a.m., for a private guided walking tour.

We will meet behind Waterside near the Spirit of Norfolk dock. Josh Weinstein, founder of Norfolk City Tour Company, will be our guide. There are 2 rest points along the way. The tour will begin near the Spirit of Norfolk dock behind Waterside and end near Nauticus. It is approximately 1-1/4 mile in length one way. It is not a loop, so you will be walking back to the original starting point, 1-1/4 mile, depending upon where you park your car. (walking approx. 2 1/2 miles total)
