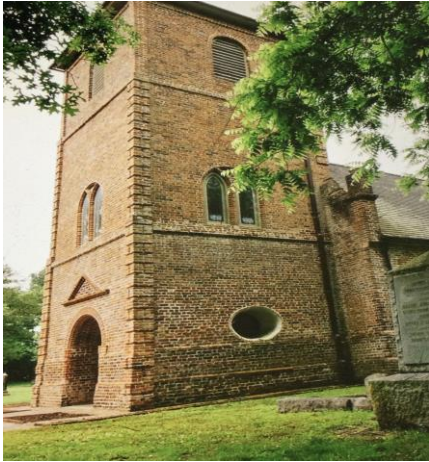


THE ILR FALL FLING '23

One day tour of historical places



Our tour begins at St. Luke's Historic Church & Museum located in Smithfield, Virginia. Evidence suggests the church was completed between 1685 and 1687. St. Luke's is the oldest surviving church building in Virginia. The church is a rare example of Artisan Mannerism Architecture combining several architectural styles. In addition to the tour, a gift shop, museum, and cemetery are available to explore.

We will hear from a hop-on guide about highlights of Smithfield as we tour the town.



Lunch will commence at the historic Smithfield Inn. Please complete your dining selection on the questionnaire form.

Optional after lunch tours: Isle of Wight Museum (\$2 admission), Walking Tour of Smithfield, Shopping on Main Street.

Before returning home, we will visit Chippokes Plantation House, Farm, and State Park, a 1,400 acre farm and park located in Surry County. This working farm (for 400 years) and state park features 20 historically significant buildings, including two houses. The brick home, built around 1855, is in the Italianate style.
